### Before You Begin

- Keep your **JEE (Advanced) 2026 Roll Number**, registered **Email ID**, and **Mobile Number** ready.
- Ensure that the email address and mobile number are active and accessible, as verification codes will be sent to them.

- JEE (Advanced) 2026 Admit Card (File size does not exceed 500KB, File format: JPG/JPEG/PNG/PDF)
- JEE Main 2026 Scorecard (File size does not exceed 500KB, File format: JPG/JPEG/PNG/PDF)
- Recent Passport Size Photograph (File size does not exceed 100KB, File format: JPG/JPEG/PNG)

9. Read the declaration carefully.

11. Click **Register and Proceed to Step 2**.

#### **After successful submission:**

1. An **IIST Registration Number** will be generated.
2. The Registration Number will also be sent to the registered Email ID.
3. Save the Registration Number for future login and correspondence.
4. Registration is not complete until the registration fee is paid.
5. Click Candidate **Login** to continue with the admission process.
